Working within a primary care model of brief therapy, the position collaborates with interprofessional care providers to provide assessment, treatment, and management of biopsychosocial aspects of health and wellbeing, ensure seamless transition to community resources as appropriate, and to support health promotion, disease prevention, and chronic disease management.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Masters or undergraduate degree in social work, psychology, or other related discipline with current registration with applicable college
- demonstrated experience in a primary health care setting, and understanding of wholistic health and well being preferred;
- good knowledge of available resources, and experience working with at risk individuals and families
- demonstrated ability to communicate effectively with a broad range of people including healthcare professionals, traditional people and community members; ability to work as a member of an interprofessional team
- willingness and ability to travel to communities to provide mental health care services in individual/group settings
- valid drivers' license, current drivers' abstract, and own vehicle required; willingness and ability to travel to communities on a regular basis
- current criminal/vulnerable persons records check
- commitment to ongoing training and professional development relevant to job requirements
