We provide primary health care through a range of options including prevention, assessment, diagnosis and treatment. Our team includes health professionals, educators and support workers representing both traditional Anishinaabe and contemporary models of care, and uses wholistic health and community development concepts.

This position will provide program support in both residential and non-residential settings for the Nanaandawe'iyewigamig Healing Lodge program located in Obashkaandagaang First Nation, member Communities, as well as at our Central Service Location. Responsibilities include monitoring and supporting clients, preparing program materials, assisting with or facilitating group sessions, and support to our EW Therapists/Counsellors. Shift work is required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- minimum Diploma in a social services field or appropriate combination of relevant education, life and work experience;
- personal experience and understanding of traditional Anishinaabe culture, values, and healing practices; experience working in an Anishinaabe organization and ability to understand and speak Anishinaabemowin a definite asset;
- demonstrated understanding of wholistic health and well-being; personal experience or strong knowledge of the healing journey and abstinence from mind altering chemicals;
- good knowledge of available resources, and experience working with at risk individuals and families an asset
- excellent verbal and written communication skills (including computer skills); demonstrated interpersonal skills to deal effectively with a wide variety of people;
- willingness and ability to travel;
- valid drivers' license and own vehicle required; copy of current drivers' abstract required
- current criminal/vulnerable persons records check;
- commitment to ongoing training and professional development relevant to job requirements
- positive attitude and capacity to act as a healthy lifestyle role model;
- proof of immunization in compliance with policy requirements is mandatory prior to start of employment;
