This is a new position, created to support transitions between various levels of care across the health care system, and integrate provincial, federal, and other health and social support services across the care continuum. The position also provides leadership and leverages the strengths of Shaawanobinesiiik Gibichii'igamig staff to facilitate access to optimal supports for clients.

NOTE: Anishinaabe traditional practices involving burning sacred medicines including tobacco, sweetgrass, sage and cedar and other cultural protocols occur regularly within our work setting.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- post secondary education in health or social services and 3-5 years' work experience, ideally involving complex case management in a community-focused setting
- Advanced Patient Navigation Level 1 & 2 Courses; Palliative Care for Front Line Workers in First Nations Communities training; Learning Essential Approaches to Palliative and End of Life Care (LEAP) an asset
- **sound understanding of Anishinaabe culture, values, and perspectives; ability to understand and speak Anishinaabemowin a definite asset**
- excellent advocacy, communication, organizational, and computer skills
- demonstrated ability to work independently while being an effective team member
- willingness and ability to travel
- valid drivers' license and own vehicle required
- proof of immunization in a policy requirement; current criminal records check also required
- commitment to ongoing training and professional development relevant to job requirements
- positive attitude and capacity to act as a healthy lifestyle role model
